"CD4 Ventura Team will respond to calls from business/property owners and staff requesting support during non-violent, non-criminal interactions with an unhoused individual. This contact number is being provided exclusively to businesses in Council District 4 along and immediately surrounding Ventura Boulevard. During the pilot phase, we appreciate you only sharing this number with other businesses in the BID to ensure the Team has the capacity to meet the needs of the intended users. Expansion of the program will be evaluated following this initial phase."

If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to call the number for assistance. As mentioned, this is a pilot program and an evaluation will take place at a later date. We want to show that the service was utilized and also be available to make suggestions on how it might be improved. Your assistance is vital to ensure we are able to measure it's effectiveness.
