

# HANGING FLOWER BASKET REPLACEMENT PROJECT



The BID had sample baskets planted with assorted succulents to ascertain the feasibility of having these year round in lieu of the artificial flowers. Due to budget concerns, it is necessary to determine how the succulents will do with limited watering.

The original plan was to water the baskets twice per month during the hotter months and once per month when it's cooler and we've had rain. Due to the incredible amounts of rain we have experienced this year, we are still unable to ascertain if this proposed watering schedule is sustainable. The sample baskets were actually watered for the first time in late April since they were planted back in January. The photos here were taken in April and, for the most part, have been holding up fairly well. We anticipate that a decision can be made by late summer. ## OWED BACK RENT?

LA Applications are NOW OPEN for ROUND 3 of the City of Los Angeles Small Business Rental Assistance Grant Program. Grants of \$2,500 up to \$15,000 will be available to eligible businesses that need financial assistance to aid in their recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic.

Businesses must be located within the City of Los Angeles and use the grants to cover some or all of any outstanding location rental fees.The grant may be used for payments in arrears incurred on or after March 1, 2020 through April 30, 2023.

Businesses must be for-profit and established by March 1, 2020 in a commercial location in the City of Los Angeles. Applications are due May 24, 2023. Be sure to tell your tenants.
